

- 1101 municipalities headed by Mayors



Colombia: Timeline of Gender and Conflict










Colombia: Women in Peace Machinery

% Women By Ministry (2019)










South Africa: Timeline of Racial and Gender Policies








Denmark: Women in Management

- Focuses on policy areas such as primary and secondary education, public works, security and welfare














SDG 13.2: Integrate climate change measures into national policies, strategies and planning

Why Climate Change?

1. Women and girls bear a disproportionate share of the environmental, economic, and social shocks of climate change

2. Building a sustainable future entails harnessing the knowledge, skills, and leadership of women in climate action







Gender, Climate Action, and Sustainable Development

Complexity of Climate Change Machinery:

 Ministries involved in climate change policy vary by country

Data Limitations:

- Limited sex-disaggregated data at the ministry level
- Lack of new country-level GEPA data available since adoption of climate change policies





















Oman: Women in Climate Change Ministries





Ghana: Women in Climate Change Ministries












Dominican Republic: Women in Climate Change Ministries




















Cambodia: Decision-Making Levels of Ministry of Environment

GEPA & Climate Change: Initial Conclusions

- Many countries lack available ministry level data
- Across countries, climate change action is tasked to different ministries
- When available, women's share of positions in climate-related ministries is typically lower than other ministries
